# Puppy Pre-School (8 weeks – 15 weeks)

Bite inhibition and socialization both should be learned while your puppy is still young.

A puppy has a key developmental period that usually ends by 12 weeks of age. These first 12 weeks are vital and crucial weeks for socialization, during this time puppies are more receptive to learning new things.

Bite inhibition needs to be thought about and addressed before 5-6 months of age when a puppy's jaw develops. When this behavior is not addressed the puppy can get hurt with these biting habits and behavior can get out of control.
